

Boesmanskloof

Two Valleys, One Trail

Also known as the Greyton–McGregor Trail, Boesmanskloof winds through the rugged Riviersonderend Mountains and is widely loved for its dramatic scenery, waterfalls, and mountain pools.

Our adventure kicks off in the beautiful town of Greyton. Our walk in is a 12-14km hike. The trail being fairly challenging. It climbs steadily for about 6 km along a jeep track toward a high viewpoint. After the climb, the route transitions into mountain paths that traverse filled with fynbos slopes, rocky passes, and quiet valleys.

Midway Highlight - Oakes Falls - a striking series of waterfalls and rock pools that make a perfect rest or lunch stop. We'll spend a few hours here relaxing.

Beyond the falls, the trail gradually descends through the conservation area toward the opposite side of the mountains, revealing expansive landscapes and diverse plant life. Once we've reached our Cottage we will unpack, light the fire and enjoy a well deserved drink and cool down in the pool.

The next day we will do a quick breakfast before taking on the 14km hike back to Greyton
